#### ELIGIBILITY

Each applicant must be a primary account holder at Texoma Educators Federal Credit Union by May 1, 2023. **The student must have their own account.**

Each applicant must apply in one of the following categories:

1. High school seniors who are graduating this year, with or without college credits.
2. College students currently enrolled or students who have completed some college hours and plan to continue their education.
3. Teachers currently employed in Grayson, Bryan, Atoka or Marshall Counties.
4. Adult students attending college for the first time or returning to school.

Each applicant must complete the application in its entirety.

This form and your retyped application must be submitted in a sealed envelope with one of the following written on the outside of the envelope: "high school senior," "college student," "teacher" or "adult student."

All scholarship recipients must attend a presentation luncheon at the Texoma Educators main office in Sherman. The luncheon will be held at 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 17, 2023 (date and time subject to change).

Previous scholarship winners are not eligible to enter the competition in the same category.

Scholarship monies must be used in the summer or fall semester of 2023 and dispersed by December 31, 2023.

**Applications must be received by 5 p.m. on Monday, May 1, 2023 at any of our credit union locations.**
